
WYSOR OPERA HOUSE

- On Main, south side of Courthouse.


- 'Becomes' Wysor Building


- East Adams between Mulberry and Jefferson

- Currently a parking lot.









- Highway 32 near Borg Warner - Mid 20th Century



- 1801 E. State Road 28 - Mid-late 20th Century








- Corner of Tillotson and River Road. - After WW2 – early 1950s. - West of Tillotson Bridge






